WALKING FROM TRAIN OR BUS STATION

Are you visiting the museum by public transport?

The museum's entrance is located on West Bar Green with easy access to the City Centre and other nearby museums and attractions. Why not leave the car at home and use public transport? The nearest tram stop to the museum is located outside Sheffield Cathedral on High Street. From here you can follow the blue markers down St James Row, continue down Paradise Street and turn left onto West Bar.

The Sheffield Bus Station is located accross the road from the main Train and Tram Station on Sheaf Street (A61).



Walking directions from Sheffield Train Station...

From leaving the Train Station by the main front exit, cross over Sheaf Street using the large pedestrian crossing and head towards the signed Bus Station.

Turn right out of the Bus Station into Pond Street and continue uphill to Flat Street then onto Fitzalan Square.

Cross over the Tram Track and turn left up High Street and then first right onto Angel Street.

Follow this road down past Snig Hill Police Station and bear left passing the Crown Courts.

With the Crown Courts on your right you will see the museum standing pride of place at the West Bar Roundabout with a pelican crossing outside the main
